A Massive Side Table (Foundation Log), Norway c. 17th-18th Century

c.1700s, Norway

A sculptural mushroom-form log, originally used as a foundation support ("stabbestokk") beneath a Norwegian stabbur, the raised storehouse traditionally elevated on such supports to protect its contents from rodents and damp. The broad, flared cap sits above a tapering base,...
